AMENDATORY ENDORSEMENT-NEBRASKA

1. Under Definitions, "Pollutants" is deleted and replaced by the following:

"Pollutants" means any solid, liquid, gaseous thermal or radioactive irritant, or contaminant, including but not limited to acids, alkalis, chemicals, fumes, smoke, soot, vapor, and waste. Waste includes materials to be recycled, reclaimed, or reconditioned, as well as disposed of.

2. Under Exclusions, Dishonest or criminal act, if applicable, is amended to include the following:

However, if the loss is caused by or results from an act of domestic abuse, this exclusion does not apply to an otherwise covered loss suffered by an insured who did not cooperate in or contribute to the act that caused the loss.

Subject to the terms under Loss Conditions and all other terms of this policy, our payment to an insured who did not cooperate in or contribute to the act that caused the loss will be limited to that person's insurable interest in the property, less any payment made to a party with a legal secured interest in the property. We retain all rights set forth in the Transfer of Rights Against Others to Us condition of this policy with regard to action against the insured that caused the loss.

3. Under Loss Conditions, B. Appraisal is amended to include the following:

This condition applies only if you and we agree to the appraisal and agree to be bound by the results established by the terms of this condition.

4. Under General Conditions, Concealment, Misrepresentation, or Fraud is amended to include the following:

No misrepresentation made by you or on your behalf in negotiation or application for this policy affects our obligations under the policy unless such misrepresentation is material, is made knowingly with intent to deceive, is relied upon by us, and deceives us to our injury.

No breach of warranty or condition affects our obligation under the policy unless the breach exists at the time of the loss and contributes to the loss.
